

Kevin Harvick Inc. (KHI) enters 2011 celebrating 10 years of NASCAR racing. From the start, co-owners Kevin and DeLana Harvick set a goal to become leaders within the industry. With two Truck Series championships to their credit, the organization has built a reputation of integrity and competitiveness within the NASCAR community. KHI is housed in an over 80,000 sq. ft. facility located in Kernersville, N.C. This season, the organization will field three full-time NASCAR Camping World Truck Series teams and two full-time NASCAR Nationwide Series teams, competing for the drivers and owners championships in each series.

Behind the wheel of the No. 33 Chevrolet for 28 of 35 Nationwide Series events in 2010, Kevin Harvick took the KHI flagship car to the winner's circle three times. With a record of 17 top-five and 26 top-10 results, he ended the season sixth in Driver Point standings and an organization-best third in the final Owner Point standings.

For 2011, Paul Menard will join KHI co-owner Harvick as well as drivers Clint Bowyer and Austin Dillon in the seat of the No. 33 Menards/Rheem Chevrolet. Led by veteran crew chief David Hyder, Menard and the No. 33 team will race towards victory lane and continue to establish KHI as one of the top teams in NASCAR competition.
